- Presentation by EADS for water line installation.
- LPSS can follow installation of pipelines for water lowering the cost significantly.
- Grant potential is high.
- 51% households low to medium income for grant requirements.
- Project cost \$5,000,000
- Reaching residents w/info on project by mailings or pamphlets placed at door of home.
- Explanation of grinder pumps and specifications for installation.
- Project should take 6 months.
- Received one email standing against proposed water/sewer project due to the fact it could change the rural feel of the neighborhood.
- No pump station in the borough due to the LPSS system.
- Tap in fee per household is \$4000. Low interest loans are available.
- Initial start time of project is late Autumn 2026.
- There will be follow up meetings scheduled later in the year to update residents.
